



<p><u>English- Narrative & Poetry</u> In English, we will be focussing on narrative writing where children explore model texts to understand structure, vocabulary and grammar. Also, we will develop a clear sequence of events, include dialogue to reveal character while also organise writing into paragraphs and using a range of conjunctions and sentence structures. In Poetry, children will study and perform different poetic forms, select vocabulary for effect, begin to use figurative language and write for a range of purposes and audiences. Guided Reading continues with Race to the Frozen North.</p>	<p><u>Maths- Fractions A (Continued) & Mass and Capacity</u> In Maths, Year 3 will continue their learning on Fractions, developing understanding of unit and non-unit fractions, recognising and showing equivalent fractions and comparing and ordering fractions using diagrams and number lines. Pupils will apply their knowledge through reasoning and problem-solving activities, explaining their thinking using mathematical vocabulary. Children will then move on to Mass and Capacity, where they will measure, compare, add and subtract amounts using grams, kilograms, millilitres and litres, and solve real-life problems involving measure.</p>	<p><u>Science- Simple forces</u> In Year 3 Science, we are focussing on Simple Forces, including how magnets work. We are learning about pushes and pulls, how forces can make objects move, stop or change direction and how magnets attract and repel different materials. We will explore which materials are magnetic and carry out simple investigations to test our ideas. It's a hands-on topic that helps us understand how forces affect the world around us!</p>
<p><u>Geography- Who lives in Antarctica?</u> In Year 3, this term we are learning about Who lives in Antarctica? We are discovering what Antarctica is like, including its freezing climate, icy landscapes and unique wildlife. We are learning about the animals that live there, such as penguins and seals and finding out about the scientists who stay there to carry out important research. Through maps, photographs and discussions, we are building our understanding of this fascinating and extreme continent.</p>	<p><u>Chambersbury Primary School</u></p>  <p>Spring 2 Year 3</p> 	<p><u>DT- Rockets</u> In Design and Technology, we will design and make a toy that uses a pneumatic system. They will develop design criteria from a design brief and generate ideas using thumbnail sketches and exploded diagrams, learning that different types of drawings help to explain ideas clearly.</p>
<p><u>Music- The Dragon Song</u> In Music, we be exploring The Dragon Song, which tells the story of Lesley the Dragon flying around the world in search of friendship. We will celebrate traditional folk tunes from around the world and learn about kindness, respect, friendship, acceptance and happiness.</p>	<p><u>PE- Tennis & Yoga</u> In PE, we will be developing our skills in both tennis and yoga. In tennis, we will practise basic techniques such as holding the racket correctly, controlling the ball and developing our hand-eye coordination through fun games and rallies. In yoga, we will focus on balance, flexibility and strength by practising different poses and breathing techniques.</p>	<p><u>PSHE- Healthy Me</u> In PSHE, we will be focussing on being Fit and Healthy, Being Safe, learning how exercise affects our heart and lungs, how to make healthy food choices and how to set our own fitness challenges. We will also learn how to be a good friend, build healthy relationships and appreciate how complex and amazing our bodies are, taking responsibility for making safe and healthy choices.</p>
<p><u>RE- What does Easter mean to Christians?</u> In RE, we will be learning about the meaning of Easter and important Christian events such as Palm Sunday, the Last Supper and Ascension Day. We explore why Palm Sunday is special, the meals Jesus shared with his disciples and why he was disappointed in them.</p>	<p><u>Computing- We are who we are</u> In Year 3 we will be exploring the unit "We Are Who We Are." In this topic, we learn about digital identity and how we present ourselves online. We discuss what personal information is, why it is important to keep certain details private, and how to stay safe when using the internet.</p>	<p><u>French- Listening & Speaking</u> In French, we will develop our listening and speaking skills by joining in with songs, repeating key words and responding to spoken language. We will explore the patterns and sounds of French making links between spelling, pronunciation and meaning.</p>
