


<p>English- Persuasive writing & Poetry</p> <p>This Summer 1 in English, we are focusing on poetry and letter writing, developing a range of creative and persuasive writing skills. In poetry, we will explore how writers use metaphor, personification and onomatopoeia to create vivid images and bring writing to life, using our senses to "show not tell." We will also experiment with techniques such as alliteration, the power of three, rhetorical questions and anecdotes to engage the reader and make our ideas memorable. Alongside this, we will learn how to write formal letters, including the correct layout, tone and language features. We will develop our grammar skills by using expanded noun phrases, fronted adverbials, conjunctions and prepositions. We will also focus on accurate punctuation, including commas and apostrophes, and use pronouns and Standard English to ensure our writing is clear, varied and engaging for the reader.</p>	<p>Maths- Decimals & Money</p> <p>This Summer 1 in Maths, we are focusing on learning about decimals and money using the White Rose Maths Year 4 scheme. We will develop our understanding of tenths and hundredths, learn how to represent and compare decimals, and apply this knowledge to real-life contexts involving money, including calculating totals, giving change and solving practical problems.</p>	<p>Science- Living things and the environment</p> <p>This Summer 1 in Science, we are focusing on living things and their environment using the Oak National Academy to support learning. We will learn about different habitats, how living things are classified, and how environments can change, exploring the impact these changes have on plants and animals.</p>
<p>Geography- What are rivers & how are they used</p> <p>This Summer 1 in Geography, we are focusing on learning about rivers and how they are used. We will explore what rivers are, how they are formed and the important role they play in the environment and in people's lives. We will also learn about the different ways rivers are used, including for transport, farming and providing water, helping us to understand their importance around the world.</p>	<p>Chambersbury Primary School</p> 	<p>Art- Facial Expression</p> <p>This Summer 1 in Art, we are focusing on exploring facial expressions through painting. We will learn how artists use colour, brushstrokes and shading to show different emotions and moods. This will help us develop our skills in observing faces carefully and expressing feelings through our artwork, building confidence in how we use paint to communicate expression.</p>
<p>Music- Blackbird by The Beatles</p> <p>This Summer 1 in Music, we are focusing on learning and performing "Blackbird" by The Beatles. We will develop our singing skills, including pitch, rhythm and expression, and learn how to perform both individually and as part of a group. We will also explore the meaning and structure of the song, building confidence and enjoyment in music.</p>	<p>PE- Athletics & Football</p> <p>This Summer 1 in PE, we are focusing on Athletics and Football. We will develop our skills in running, jumping and throwing in athletics, as well as improving our teamwork, control and coordination through football. These activities will help us build fitness, confidence and good sportsmanship while working both independently and as part of a team.</p>	<p>PSHE- Healthy me</p> <p>This Summer 1 in PSHE, we are focusing on relationships, emotions and wellbeing. We will explore feelings such as jealousy, understanding what can cause it, how it can affect relationships and ways to manage these emotions through problem-solving and talking to trusted adults. We will also develop our critical thinking skills, learning to question what we see online and understand that social media does not always show the full picture. In addition, we will learn about love and loss, exploring different types of loss and the emotions linked to the grief cycle, recognising that all feelings are natural and change over time. We will understand the importance of support from family, friends and trusted adults.</p>
<p>RE- Why are sacred texts important to people?</p> <p>This Summer 1 in RE, we are focusing on why sacred texts are important to people, linking our learning to Christianity, Hinduism, spirituality and Humanism. We will explore religious texts such as the Bible and the Vedas, understanding how they guide believers in their daily lives and are treated with respect. We will also consider how people express their beliefs through spirituality and explore Humanist views, recognising that not everyone follows a sacred text but may still have strong values and beliefs. This will help us understand different perspectives and the importance of respect for all beliefs.</p>	<p>Computing- We are artists</p> <p>This Summer 1 in Computing, we are focusing on the "We Are Artists" unit from the Switched On Computing Year 4 scheme. We will explore how digital technology can be used creatively to produce artwork, developing our skills in using different tools and software. This will help us express our ideas digitally while building confidence in creativity, design and computing skills.</p>	<p>French- The carnival of animals</p> <p>This Summer 1 in French, we are focusing on "The Carnival of Animals." We will learn the names of different animals in French, practise speaking and listening skills, and begin to describe animals using simple sentences. This will help us build confidence in using French vocabulary while developing our pronunciation and understanding.</p>
