


<p>English</p> <p>In English they will be using the text 'The Book of Mythical Beasts and Magical Creatures' by Stephen Krensky to practise using the features of a non-chronological report. After this they will be using the poem 'The Highwayman' by Alfred Noyes to use the features of a narrative poem.</p> <p>Spellings will cover the following: words ending with 'er' 'or' and 'ar' words beginning with 'ac'</p> <p>words with the prefixes 'dis' 'un' 'over' and 'im' as well as the challenge words which are year 5/6 common exception words</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>In Spring 2, they will cover fractions, decimals and percentages and area, perimeter and volume. In the fractions, decimals and percentages unit they will recap their learning on finding the area and perimeter of rectangles and rectilinear shapes. They will then explore finding the area of different triangles and parallelograms. They will recap their learning on volume and will be introduced to a cubic centimetre (cm³) as a unit of measure for volume.</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>In science they will be learning about 'Changing Circuits'. Within this unit they will about the components of simple circuits. How to draw diagrams of circuits. Investigate voltage as well as plan and carry out an investigation linked to changing variables within a circuit. After this they will be introduced to buzzers and switches within a circuit.</p>
<p>Geography</p> <p>This term we will be learning about where our energy comes from. They will learn why energy is important; how energy is generated and distributed, as well as investigating where the best place to put a solar panel would be in our school</p>	<p>Chambersbury Primary School</p> 	<p>Art: Drawing / Photography</p> <p>They will create memorable portraits of each other for a leavers' book. They will explore and use a range of media to create portraits as well as explore and use the skills and techniques used by famous artists</p>
<p>Music</p> <p>This half term we will be basing our learning on the song 'You've got a friend' by Carol King. During this unit the children will learning to sing the song and use a range instruments to accompany the song.</p>	<p>PE</p> <p>Tuesdays PE will be football. They will develop their understanding of attacking and defending. They will practise maintaining possession as well as moving a ball towards a goal to score.</p> <p>Fridays will be athletics. They will be set challenges for distance and time using different styles and combinations of running, jumping and throwing.</p>	<p>PSHE</p> <p>The children will focus on a unit called 'Healthy Me'. During this unit they will explore how to have a healthy body and a healthy mind. This will include eating a healthy diet and how to keep physically fit as well as exploring friendships. It will also include how to keep calm and deal with difficult situations.</p>
<p>RE</p> <p>In RE they will be learning about the founders of faiths and their importance for people today. This will include the importance of Jesus to Christians & expressing faith in art, drama and song (meditation).</p>	<p>Computing</p> <p>In computing they will complete a unit called 'We are connected' developing skills for social media. This will include appropriate rules or guidelines for a civil online discussion; showing respect and tolerance towards the views of others as well as strategies for dealing with online bullying.</p>	<p>French</p> <p>In French they will learning about the world around us. Through this unit they will revisit some basic everyday vocabulary as well as constructing simple sentences through speaking, listening reading singing and writing in French.</p>
