Therapeutic Thinking

This week, I completed a refresher for my Therapeutic Thinking tutor role, further strengthening our commitment to supporting every child at Chambersbury Primary School.

The Therapeutic Thinking approach helps us to understand the reasons behind behaviour and respond in a way that supports pupils to develop the skills, confidence and resilience they need to succeed. By focusing on positive relationships, empathy and understanding, we can create an environment where pupils feel safe, valued and ready to learn.

This approach aligns closely with our school vision: that every individual is cared for deeply, valued and respected, and that all members of our community have the opportunity to learn in an environment full of excitement and fun. Through Therapeutic Thinking, we continue to nurture a positive school culture where pupils can flourish, develop a strong sense of belonging, and grow into the "change-makers" and "assets" we know they can become.

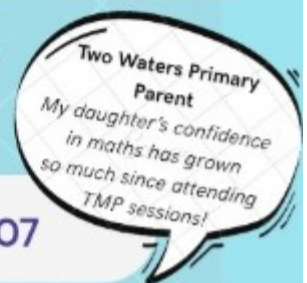
