Her creativity, dedication and belief in our pupils resulted in a performance that was unique to Chambersbury and perfectly showcased the incredible talents of our children.

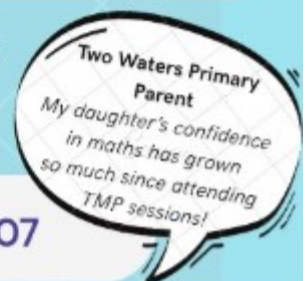
