Police at Chambersbury

Last week Reception had a visit from a police officer who spoke to the pupils about the role of the police and how they are here to help. Following this session, I gave the PC a tour of our school and he took questions from many of our pupils. Having enjoyed his visit to our school and been so impressed with what we are doing at Chambersbury, later in the day the PC returned with a couple of his colleagues. They observed the end of day pick up procedures and how our pupils leave school calmly and safely; the police also gave advice to motorists about how to park with consideration to pedestrians. Please ensure your children are only accessing APPS and games that are age appropriate – APP's such as Snapchat, Facebook, Instagram, TikTok and X have age ratings of 13+ and shouldn't be used by any pupil at Chambersbury as they present a safeguarding risk; likewise, games that have 'frequent scenes of violence,' such as Fortnite are also not suitable for primary aged pupils. We all have to work together to safeguard children in school and outside of school.

After school childcare will be available at Chambersbury in the summer term – this will give pupils the option to stay at school until 6:00pm, which I hope is very helpful for working parents in particular. 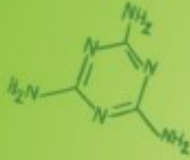
