Pupil Progress

This week I have been meeting with teachers to discuss our pupils progress in English and Maths. In these meetings we discuss barriers to learning, such as attendance, and what provision we can put in to support. The staff at Chambersbury put a huge amount of support in place for pupils and it is great to see this having real impact. We consider how we can adapt provision for groups of pupils as well as for individuals for example, following our pupil progress meetings in the Autumn we changed our approach to teaching maths fluency across the entire school. I am confident, that for a second year running, we will once again have record breaking data this year!

Whilst these meetings focus on academic progress, I also want to share that the way teachers talk about your children is absolutely heart-warming. When I took on the Headteacher role at Chambersbury, I spoke about wanting to lead a school with love and I can truly say the staff here love your children and love, not just teaching them, but also spending time with them.

Snacks

At break times pupils are allowed healthy snacks such as a piece of fruit or vegetables. These healthy snacks, along with a good breakfast, can help pupils concentrate in their lessons as they work hard. Snacks that are ultra processed or are unhealthy such as crisps and chocolate aren't suitable snacks as they have the opposite impact on pupils that we are aiming for.

Pupil Premium Grant

I would highly recommend that you check whether your child qualifies for free school meals/PPG, if you do our school could get extra funding called 'Pupil Premium' which can be used to pay for additional staff time, books, trips, etc.

Our Reception class has been taking part in a Raising Good Level of Development programme this year and already we have seen an increase of 16.2% in the percentage of pupils we expect to meet the standard by the end of the year.

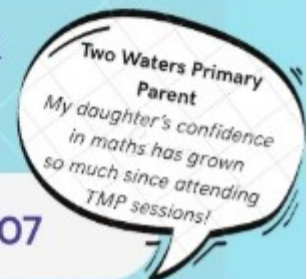
